# Employment Equity in the Federal Public Service:

The Standing Senate Committee on Human Rights wrote people with disabilities are "appointed at a lower rate through the PSC and hired at a lower rate as per the most recent hiring statistics in the TBS annual report." Furthermore, it states, "half of the people with disabilities employed by the Federal Public Service are aged 50 years or older, while the representation rate of persons with disabilities under 35 is only 2.8 (compared to a workforce availability of 4.0% for this group as a whole)."
