

# Labour Day Parade 2018

## Frequently Asked Questions

**Date, Time & Location?:** Monday, September 3<sup>rd</sup> 8:30AM registration opens (setup 7:30)  
@ University Ave north bound lanes curbside south of Dundas St. north of Armoury St.

### **I have trouble walking, is there any way for me to attend?**

There will be a passenger van available to ride in if you are unable to walk the route. If you wish to ride in the van, please contact the Labour Day Parade committee. Families are encouraged to bring bikes, roller blades and other things to ride in throughout the route. We are also pursuing a float for older folks and children to ride and cheer marchers on.

### **In the past I've showed up around 9 am and the float didn't get going until 11 am. How long will I be waiting for the parade to begin?**

The floats are divided into 10 sections. Each section has a group of floats from beginning to end. We are in section 7a, along with 4 other floats. The first float leaves by 9:30 am so we should be leaving on the parade route by 10ish. You can be a Flag bearer and leave with front of Parade, Coordinate Banner or help with decorations to pass the time. We are also hoping there will be some GTA Committee exhibits available to help "Mobilize Justice" All in all there is lots to do for everyone and we should reach the ex before the air show begins.

### **I'd like to know if my children are able to receive a t-shirt for the parade?**

Bring your family, bring your friends, bring anyone who would like to come out to the parade. The shirts will be first come, first serve for members till about 9am. Usually there are enough shirts to allow visible volunteers to also get a shirt for getting involved...

### **When can I receive my wristband to get into the CNE?**

When you show up to the parade site and register you receive a wrist band. Registration should be behind the float. If you are participating in the parade for PSAC you will receive a wristband, but you must be present at the start of the parade to be eligible to receive one. We must apply the wristband at registration.

### **What will be given to participants?**

Each person attending the parade for the PSAC will be given a coupon for refreshments (water, chips, prize draw ) a wristband to the CNE and for members while quantities last a PSAC T-shirt.

### **What will be the parade route?**

The parade will leave Dundas and University, go down University, go along Queen St go south on Dufferin through the gates. Those on foot will go directly into the CNE or disperse. Those on float and vehicles will need to disembark just past gate.
